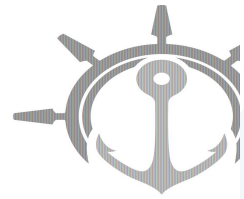
Victory College structure - 2025/26



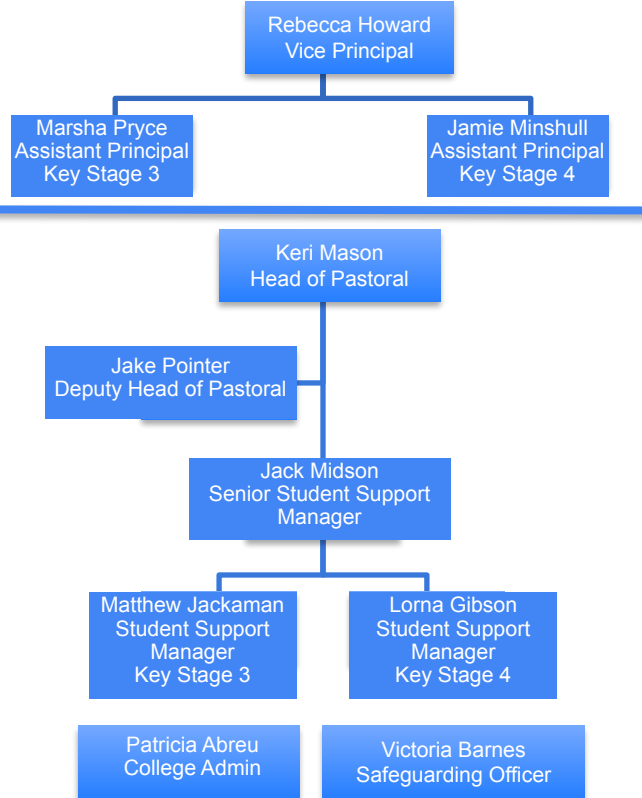
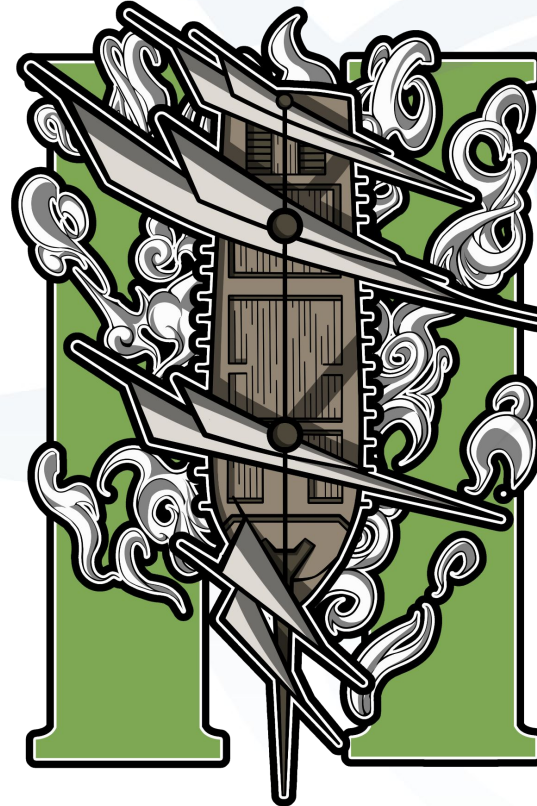

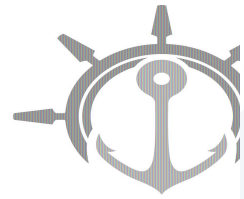
Hercules College structure - 2025/26



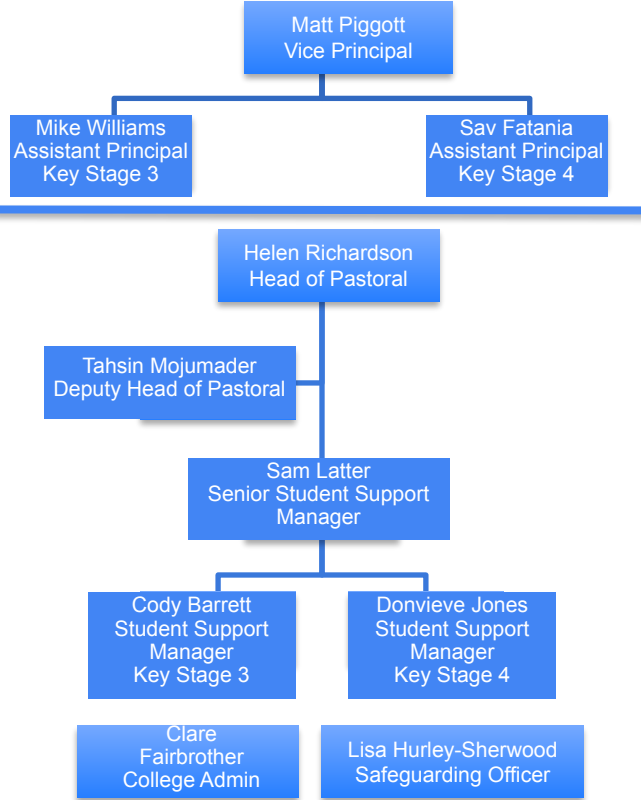
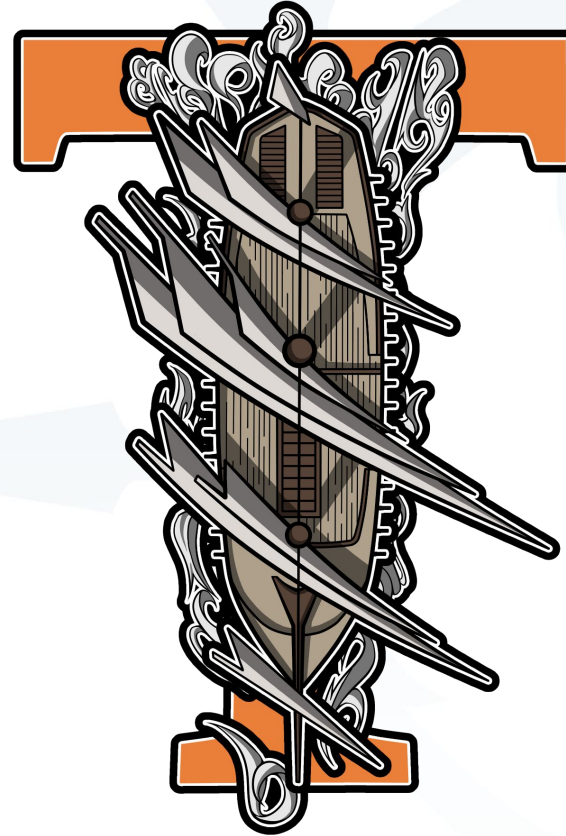

Enhanced Transition to ensure that students meet key staff, familiarise themselves with the building and become familiar with the secondary school environment


3 wave approach to transition
